Farm Plans

- Number of Farm Plans completed: **12** (*Project target is 20*). Currently liaising with Natural England over SAC Site Improvement Plans (SIPs) and targeting farms accordingly.
- Number of Farm Plans underway: 3

Trees

- Number of trees planted: **1743** trees (*Project target is 6000 trees*).
- Further tree planting agreed: At least 1150 trees (Newby Beck, Meaburn Hall, Rosgill Hall, Halligill, Croglin High Hall and Davygill).

Farm improvement work

 - Dedra Banks at Newby completed clean and dirty water separation work in farm yard (£5k);
 - **Crake Trees** at Maulds Meaburn completed creation of sediment collection pond as part of fencing, re-meandering and tree planting project.
 - Towcett at Shap completed clean and dirty water separation work in farm yard (£5k);
 - Low Rutter at Hoff completed new cattle track (£5k).

In-stream habitat improvement

- In-stream habitat improvement work completed (Project target 5 locations):
 - Crake Trees at Maulds Meaburn completed 75 m of re-meandering of Howe Beck, a tributary of the River Lyvennet, Grid ref. Top 62278 15956, Mid 62288 15991, Bottom 62277 16024;
 - Crossrigg House at Cliburn removed 1 main weir and 6 smaller weirs on Morland Beck, a tributary of the River Lyvennet, Grid ref. Top 60148 23500, Mid 60396 23559, Bottom 60547 23618 (450 m of river habitat improved and 2 km of Morland Beck opened up to migratory fish).

Risks and Issues

- Farm Plans 3 Farm Plans to complete and 5 Farm Plans still to start On target for completion March 2015;
- Number of trees planted 1150 trees agreed but still to plant and 3000 trees still to be agreed by March 2015 – behind target but achievable by March 2015;
- **Fencing** 15,000 m agreed but still to install and approx. 1500 m still to find behind target with installation but all achievable by March 2015;
- Improvement work on farms to reduce diffuse pollution 12 farm improvement works planned but still to complete and 4 farm improvement works still to find behind target but achievable by March 2015.
- In-stream habitat improvement Completed.
- Crayfish survey and involvement of volunteers Completed for 2012 & 2013 and planned for 2014 survey season – On target.
